**Voting by mail is EASY.** Just sign, date, and complete the application. Drop it in the mail and you will receive a ballot from your local registrar which you can complete and return without ever leaving your home. No waiting in line.

**Voting by mail keeps you healthy and safe.** The best way to protect yourself, your family, and your whole community during this time is to vote by mail.

**Voting by mail ensures coronavirus cannot take away your ability to vote.**

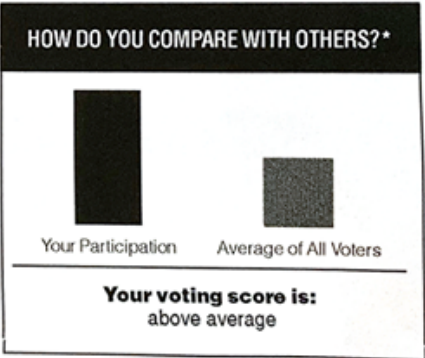
You can even research the candidates as you vote.
